

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
ADVANCE STANDING CREDIT

GRAPHICS TECHNOLOGY
(Web Design)

Brevard Community College (BCC) will award postsecondary advance standing credit to eligible high school students who have met the criteria as stated below. *The student will not be charged tuition or fees for the postsecondary credit awarded through this advance standing credit agreement.* Listed below are the courses that must be completed at the secondary level:

High School Course Number	High School Course Title	High School Credit

8207120	Web Design 2	1

BCC will award advance standing credit for the college course listed below.

College Course Number	Brevard Community College Course Title	College Credit
GRAC 2721	Web Site Design	3

The procedure for obtaining the advance standing credit will be in accordance with the following criteria.

1. Student must meet the following criteria:
 - Cumulative grade point average of 3.0 in the above mentioned Brevard Public School Web Design courses.
 - High School Graduation or GED
 - After graduation, apply to BCC and select the appropriate Graphics Technology degree or certificate (refer to the BCC catalog for applicable major code).
 - Enroll in a BCC Graphics Technology degree or certificate program and successfully complete 12 college credits or the remaining credits in a college credit certificate. The *required* pre-requisite courses as specified below must be completed with a grade of "C" or better in the program for which the advance standing credit is to be awarded.

REQUIRED college course sequence to complete in order to receive the accelerated credit:

GRAC 1100 Principles of Design (3 credits)
GRAC 2157 Integrated Design (3 credits)
GRAC 2150 Raster Graphics (3 credits) (Note that this course may be waived for students who complete Brevard Public Schools' Digital Design 1 & 2 or Communications Technology 1, 2 & 3 with a "B" average or higher. Students may seek the Advance Standing Credit option and abide by the most recent Memorandum of Understanding. Students must enroll in BCC's Graphics program no less than three years after high school graduation and complete appropriate courses in the Graphics program with grades of "C" or higher.)
GRAC 2156 Vector Graphics (3 credits) (Note that this course may be waived for students who complete Brevard Public Schools' Digital Design 1 & 2 or Communications Technology 1, 2 & 3 with a "B" average or higher. Students may seek the Advance Standing Credit option and abide by the most recent Memorandum of Understanding. Students must enroll in BCC's Graphics program no less than three years after high school graduation and complete appropriate courses in the Graphics program with grades of "C" or higher.)

- Continued -

Students must refer to the college catalog at time of starting BCC for the most up-to-date programs and required courses.

2. Following completion of the required credits at BCC, the student must petition the Registrar to have advance standing credit placed on their permanent record. Credit will be awarded with the grade of "S" which will not affect the GPA.
3. The student must enroll in the appropriate BCC courses or program no later than three years after the last high school attendance.

Questions regarding this agreement should be addressed to the appropriate Brevard Community College program Dean of Career and Technical Education, and/or Director, Career and Technical Education, Brevard Public Schools.

This Memorandum of Understanding shall be effective upon the signature of the district superintendent or his designee and the community college president or his designee. This agreement shall remain in effect until reviewed and modified every two years, or terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice prior to the end of a term or by mutual consent.
