Career and Technical Education (CTE)
2010-2011 CTE CHOICE Application Process**

The Brevard School District is in the process of approving application procedures for identified Choice programs. The purpose is to coordinate the timelines and registration procedures of all the choice schools/programs.

- ◆ Orientation and information meetings at high schools may be held from November 2009 – February 2010.
- ◆ Applications for CTE-CHOICE will be available at each high school and on-line at www.CTEbrevard.com by December 1, 2009.
- ◆ **All Choice applications are due to the REQUESTED HIGH SCHOOL by 4:00 p.m. on February 22, 2010. Faxed applications will not be accepted.**
- ◆ If necessary, student selection will be by lottery to be held by March 3 – March 5, 2010.
- ◆ High schools will provide Notification Letters to families regarding their acceptance for a Choice School/Program by March 19, 2010.
- ◆ High Schools hold registration and commitment meetings April 6 – April 8, 2010.
- ◆ Students/Parents only sign **one** commitment letter. It is the responsibility of the student/parent to make sure the Requested high school has received the **Commitment Letter** to **ONE** Choice Program/School by **4:00 p.m. April 12, 2010**

Students who submit a commitment letter to more than one school/program will be disqualified to attend any choice program/school for the school year.

The approval of a student to attend a school other than his/her zoned school of attendance for the purpose of attending a choice school or program is valid for as long as the student participates in the choice school/program. A student must return to his/her zoned school of attendance at the end of the semester if he/she no longer participates in the choice school or program.
