

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN JOHNSON & WALES UNIVERSITY
AND THE NATIONAL ACADEMY FOUNDATION (NAF) on behalf of a
member program of NAF: ACADEMY OF FINANCE
New York, New York**

The purpose of this document defines terms through which students can make a smooth transition from the National Academy Foundations' curriculum established for the Academy of Finance into the post-secondary education program. This document describes advantages that students will have at Johnson & Wales as a result of their successful completion of NAF's Academy of Finance program.

Stipulations of the Agreement:

- Students are expected to complete the required admissions application process by submitting official high school transcripts. Upon acceptance to Johnson & Wales University, a student will be eligible for consideration of the articulation agreement.
- Students must indicate their participation in the Academy of Finance program on the admission application.
- Students must earn a certificate of completion from the Academy to earn transfer credits at Johnson & Wales University towards an Associate's degree.
- Students must earn a minimum cumulative grade point average of B in the Academy of Finance program to earn transfer credits.
- Students must forward one letter of recommendation from an Academy instructor with their application.
- *Students who complete the above stipulations and enroll in the Financial Services Management Associates program at the Providence campus will be eligible for the following college credits:
